### Sorted by: Name

The data provided in these rankings are calculated based on the same performance index method that is used to rank schools and districts in reading, writing, and mathematics. Schools and districts receive a rank based on their index score. A rank of "1" represents the best performance. When a previous index score is available, a separate ranking is also calculated based on the improvement in the index score from one year to the next year. Schools or districts that have the same index score (or the same improvement in index score) earn the same rank. The schools and districts are sorted three ways: alphabetically, by index score ranking, and by improvement ranking.

The data provided in these rankings are calculated based on the same performance index method that is used to rank schools and districts in reading, writing, and mathematics. Schools and districts receive a rank based on their index score. A rank of "1" represents the best performance. When a previous index score is available, a separate ranking is also calculated based on the improvement in the index score from one year to the next year. Schools or districts that have the same index score (or the same improvement in index score) earn the same rank. The schools and districts are sorted three ways: alphabetically, by index score ranking, and by improvement ranking.
